## Brooke Forbes Legacy Fund Newsletter - December 2011

Dear Friends of Brooke,

We have news to share with you regarding our 2011 recipient of the Brooke Forbes Legacy Fund.

Thanks to your support, we had \$2200 to award to a charitable organization for the purposes of introducing minority youth to the joy of making radio.

This year, the funds have gone to establish an internship at Red FM which bills itself as Vancouver's Number One South Asian Radio Station. It's a community-based station in Surrey, BC's second largest and fastest growing city where a large number of immigrants from South Asia settle.

The intern will be a young immigrant identified and supported by the Immigrant Serving Organization, MOSAIC. MOSAIC offers several programs for immigrant youth including violence prevention programs, popular theatre, and job finding and settling in Canada services. MOSAIC will also publicize the internship on its website and in its print newsletter. (As some of you know, I work at MOSAIC, not in the Department that will be overseeing this project, and in the interests of full disclosure, I did not vote when the Forbes Fund Advisory Committee considered MOSAIC's application.)
